


In keeping with our mission of providing health care to all individuals regardless of their ability to pay, Stephens County Hospital provides more than \$10.7 million in charity, uncompensated care and bad debt each year. Our population of approximately 25,751, 59% of which are located in rural areas, need access to the healthcare provided by Stephens County Hospital. This is why it is so vitally important that you partner with us by contributing to the Georgia Rural Health Tax Credit. Your donation can help us ensure that quality healthcare is available to our community.

The Georgia Legislature has recognized a rural health crisis in Georgia. They implemented the Rural Health Tax Credit program to incentivize individuals, c-corporations and trusts to make donations to rural hospitals in return for a tax credit. You will receive a tax credit on your Georgia State Income taxes equal to 90% of your donation. You may also count this as a regular deduction on your Federal taxes. Stephens County Hospital is eligible for this program. Your donation will assist us in purchasing radiology equipment, computer systems and related equipment so important to healthcare today. Your donations will also allow us to do some much needed building retrofits on items such as roofing, air handlers and much of which is fifty years old. We serve an aging population (as outlined in the demographics listed on page 2) with many health challenges, the need for state-of-the-art technology and equipment is a must. Your investment in Stephens County Hospital will help us restore and enhance our facilities, purchase new equipment and develop new programs that will enrich the great services and care that we provide to our community.




