Awarding Excellence IN PATIENT SAFETY

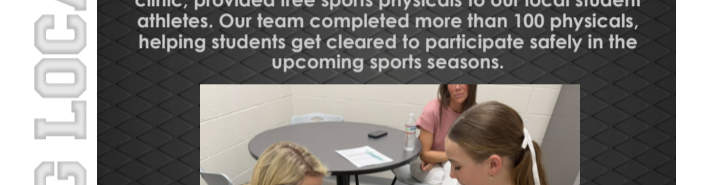

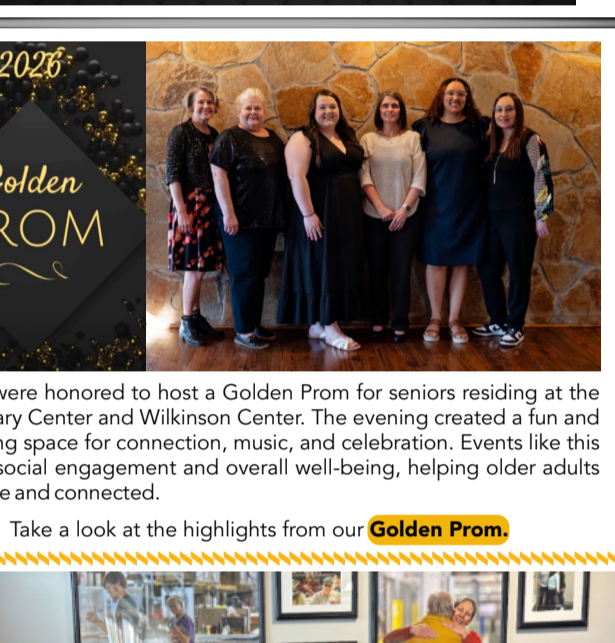

2026 Golden PROM



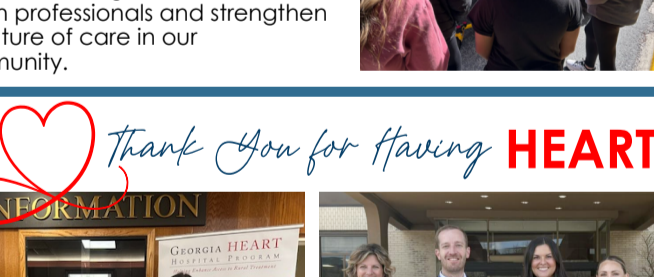

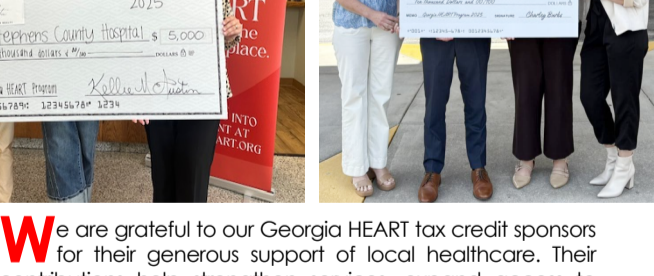
ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

Our team also traveled to Habersham County for their annual Senior Health Fair, where we provided information to support healthy aging.



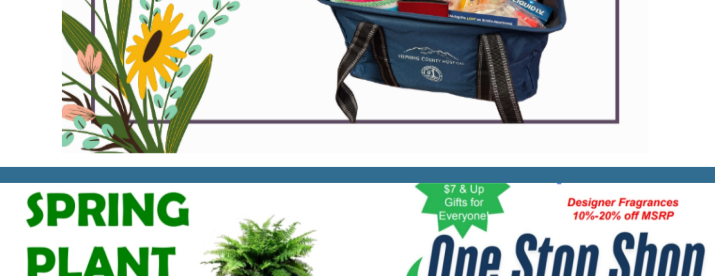
Our teams from Orthopedics and Arrowhead Health and Wellness Clinic enjoyed a day at the ballfield for Toccoa Little League's Opening Day events.



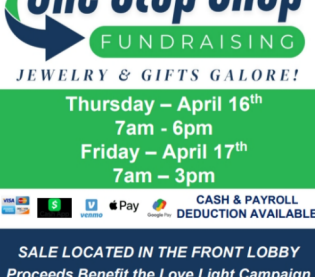
We continue to strengthen partnerships and make it easier for our community to stay informed and proactive about their health.
